


Minutes of the Meeting of the Ethics Committee

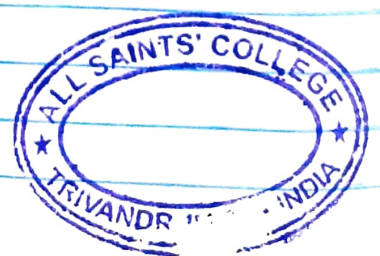


