


Report on the Student Attributes facilitated by the institution through policy on ethics.

The Ethics Policy of the college stipulates that

- 2. students being guided in ethical conduct be inspired to follow these principles through talks, direct interactions and involved participation.
- 3. time be set aside in the operational schedule of the institution for instructing students in ethical practices.
- 4. the mode of instruction must be inclusive, participative and amicable.
- 5. the students must be given ample time to reflect and debate on modes of ethical conduct.
- 6. while attending ethics classes and related programmes is ideal, it will not be considered mandatory to attend these initiatives in order to obtain any document indicating status-quo or qualification from the institution.

- Participation for social, cultural and economic transformation

Over the years, the college has organized **Blood Donation drives** under the aegis of the NSS and other committed organisations such as Terumo Penpol in which the students of the college participated whole-heartedly.

The college has also organised **medical camps** for the villages in the vicinity, with participation by the students.

The students of the college have organised **food festivals** and donated the money collected to the **Regional Cancer Centre**, Thiruvananthapuram.

There are regular food donation drives to **Old Age homes** such as Akasha Paravakal as well as outreach programmes among the needy.

The students collect White Gifts every Christmas and donate the same to the needy to spread cheer.
